

E. Spruce Avenue Improvements – Church to Academy

Highlights

The City is conducting a pavement preservation project on E. Spruce Avenue from Church Street to Academy Street. The project was awarded to Rognlin's, Inc. and work will begin in June 2020. The overlay and repairs will be substantially complete by the end of July. City crews will be replacing the pavement at the Spruce Avenue and Church Street intersection while the contractor is working on the adjacent roadway.

Why is the City Repairing this Section of E. Spruce?

The pavement is getting old and the driving surface has failed in many areas. Drainage issues at the intersection of Spruce and Chehalis need to be corrected and curb ramps at the Chehalis and Academy intersections need to be updated so that the project is eligible for funding from the Washington State Transportation Improvement Board (TIB).

The End Result

- Pavement between Church and Academy will be replaced with an asphalt overlay.
- Drainage at the Chehalis intersection will be improved.
- Asbestos Cement water main in the norther part of Chehalis will be taken out of service and replaced with PVC water main.
- Access to the sidewalks for disabled pedestrians will be improved at the Chehalis and Academy intersection.

Timeline (subject to changes and updates)

- The majority of the project will be conducted during June and early July 2020

Funding

This project is funded by a \$111,000 grant from TIB and \$225,000 from various City funding sources (Real-estate Excise Tax, Street General, Stormwater Construction and Water Capital Projects).

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
